



POSTAGE STAMP KEEPS CESAR'S LEGACY ALIVE

Glendale, Calif. – On April 23, 2003, the 10th anniversary of Cesar's passing, the Cesar E. Chavez Foundation, in conjunction with the United States Postal Service, issued the Cesar Chavez commemorative stamp.

To date, approximately 10,594,608 Chavez commemorative stamps have been sold throughout the country, exposing countless numbers of people to the life, work and values of Cesar Chavez. According to Postal officials, the number of Chavez commemorative stamps sold will continue to rise until the Postal Service raises the price of first-class postage.

The Chavez commemorative stamp is a tribute to Cesar's legacy and has helped to ensure that his values and principles continue to inspire people to make a difference in their own lives, in their communities and in the world as a whole.
