



Musical Drama about Cesar Chavez Premieres at Goodman Theatre

Chicago, Ill. – The Goodman Theatre selected the musical drama *Let the Eagle Fly*, the story of Cesar Chavez and the Farm Worker Movement, as part of its July 2004 International Latino Theatre Festival.

The orchestrations for Shannon's score, for this musical, are by world-renowned orchestrator Larry Blank, whose recent work includes orchestrations for the Tony Ward winning Broadway musical *The Producers* and the hit movie *Chicago!*
