## About Our Program:

- Leverages personalized online instruction through initial and post student diagnostic
- Social-emotional learning lessons designed to teach students about Cesar Chavez's Core Values
- Small group differentiated instruction
- Program staff works closely with families and school stakeholders to ensure high student participation
- Employs a collaborative approach to customize a fully managed program to meet students' needs

## Key Features:

- 1 Teacher: 10 students (1:10) after-school instruction
- Leverages research-based personalized, interactive, and adaptive digital curriculum
- Family partnership approach in designing flexible program schedule with parent's input
- Ongoing technical support to families through a laptop loan program, if needed
- Encourages student participation through completion certificate and incentives
- Taught by culturally competent credentialed teachers

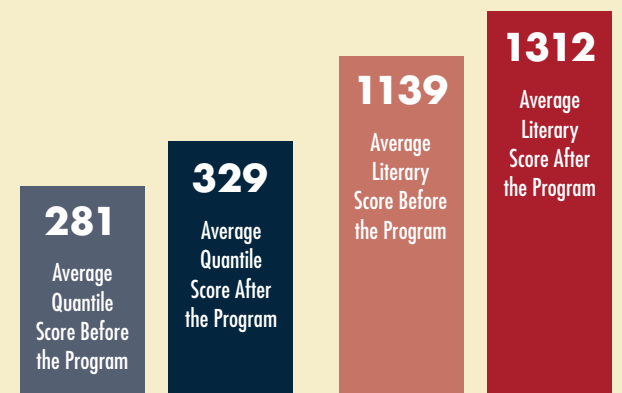
