About Our Program:

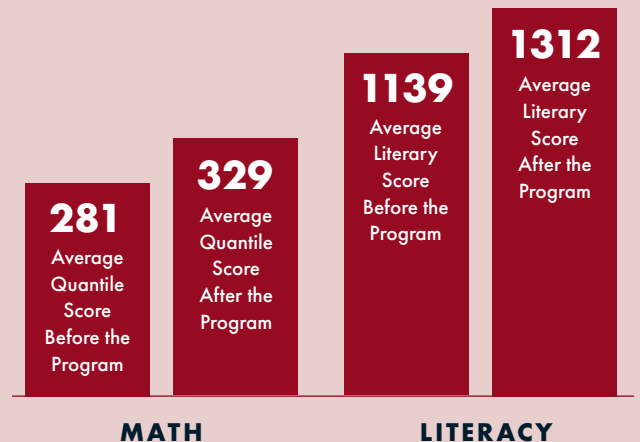
- Personalized adaptive curriculum with pre/post assessments to meet all SSDP requirements
